Entrance Scholarship for Students Entering a University Program

The High Cost of Higher Education

Your child wants to continue their education. Can you afford it? Can your family? Tuition continues to rise at Canadian universities making it more difficult for Albertans to realize the dream of higher education.

Children or grandchildren of an active Alberta REALTOR® are eligible to apply for the Al Larson Memorial Scholarship, worth \$2,500, for a student having achieved first-time acceptance into an academic university program and entering their post-secondary program in September 2017 or January 2018.

Please Note: A REALTOR® is a real estate practitioner who belongs to the local real estate board. Children and grandchildren of industry members who do not belong to a real estate board are not eligible for this award.

The History

Al Larson dedicated 41 continuous years to the real estate industry, both as a REALTOR® and as an administrator. He was a past president of the Alberta Real Estate Association (AREA) and an honorary life member of both AREA and the Canadian Real Estate Association (CREA). The Edmonton, Calgary and West Central Alberta real estate boards also granted Al honorary life memberships.

In 1976 he was appointed executive vice president of AREA, a position he held until his retirement in 1990. Al Larson passed away suddenly while at a CREA conference in October 1991.

Al never looked for public recognition. His generous contribution of time and energy to the industry was always "behind the scenes". Highly respected by REALTORS® and executive officers across Canada, his statesmanship and outstanding leadership benefited organized real estate at all levels. Outside of real estate, Al was a true family man and contributor to his community.

The Criteria

Applications will be graded on both academic and extra-curricular achievement. Al Larson's commitment to both his industry and community has inspired the benchmarks for this scholarship through the Alberta Real Estate Association. It is our belief that the successful candidate is involved in a wide range of activities that extends further than academics.

Applicants are expected to have achieved not only above average scholastic performance but to have involved themselves at a high level in other non-scholastic endeavours. These could include but are not limited to:

- Athletics
- Fine arts
- School / community service
- Charitable works

Academic achievement will be assessed based upon a certified copy of the applicant's final transcript which can be mailed to them by the Government of Alberta. This will include all Grade 11 or 12 marks along with provincial exam results. Achievement will be graded using the following courses:

- English 30
- Social 30
- Math 30
- 2 of Math 31, Biology 30, Physics 30, and Chemistry 30

Extra-curricular involvement will be assessed based upon the following criteria:

- Participation on student council or committees
- Participation in school/community clubs
- Participation in sports, theatre, band, etc.
- Volunteerism
- Student's reputation as an all-around good citizen
- Playing a leadership role within school/community

Applicants are encouraged to expand on their accomplishments via a written description of their citizenship, letters of reference, a resume or any combination of the above.
